## *Ruby Pipeline*

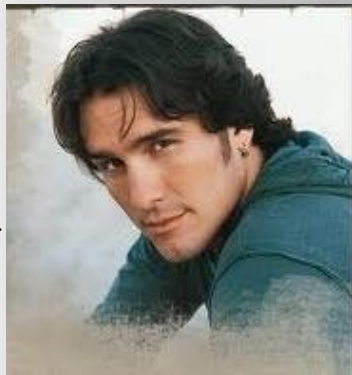

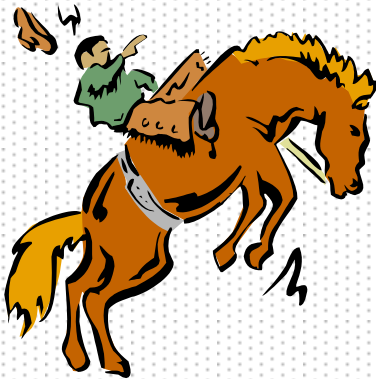
